

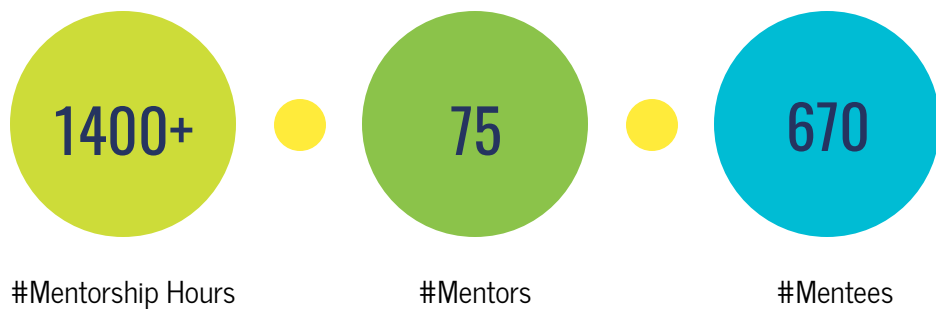
2020~21 Annual Report

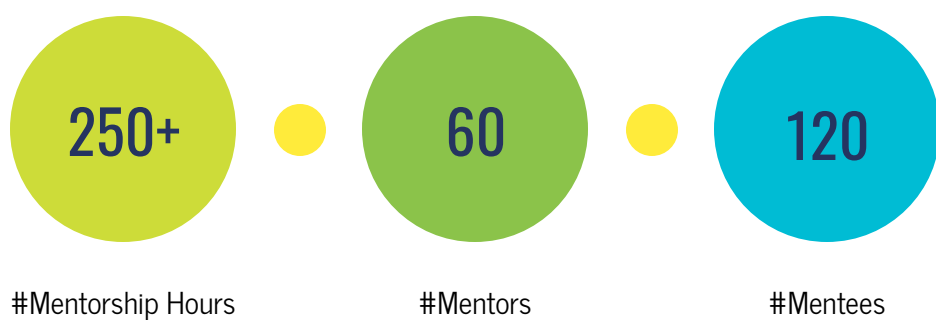

1:1 Long Term Mentorship

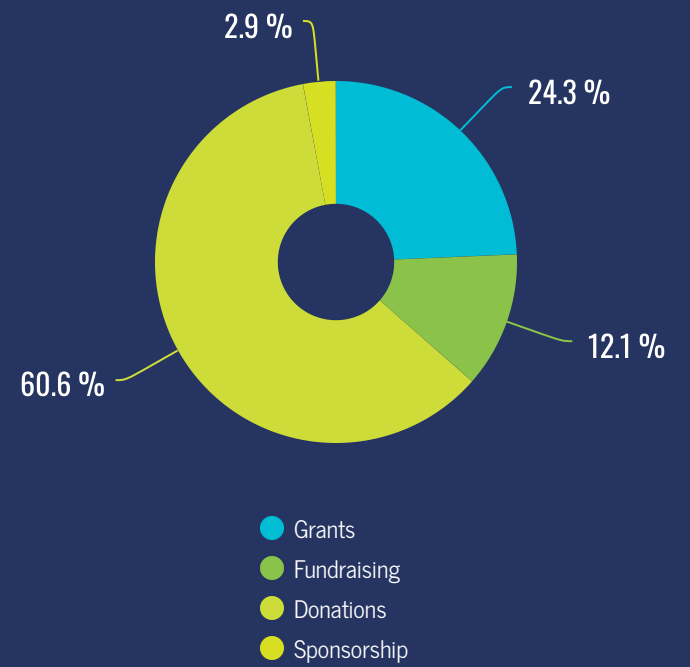
Our mentorship program tries to connect IranWiC members to each other based on their needs and skills so that they can get support in any stage of their professional life.

Virtual Speed Mentoring

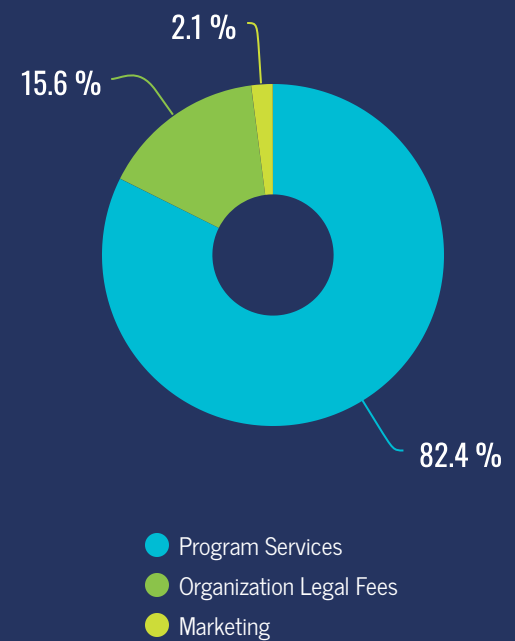
The goal of these events is to connect the community members in larger groups from all over the US so that they can expand their network and learn from the experience of the Iranian experts in academia and industry.
